- 2. All games will be played on handicap.
- 3. There will be 2 pools Pool A and Pool B.
- 4. To played as a knock out competition, with winners going into a semi final on Friday with the winners going through to the finals on Monday.
- 5. The four losing teams on Wednesday will play off on Friday for a place in the Subsidiary Final on Monday. Due to time constraints the losers matches will occur on Sunday.
- 6. It must be understood by all teams that this tournament is being run in conjunction with the RAS Polo and all game times will be organized to work in with the game times at the Royal Easter Show.
- 7. Windsor Polo Club adopts a Zero Tolerance Policy on the use of bad language and penalties will be awarded accordingly.
- 8. In the event of bad weather or any unforeseen circumstances, the tournament committee reserves the right to change game locations and times. Any such changes will be posted on the notice board in the clubhouse, and is the responsibility of team captains to ensure their team is aware of any changes.
- 9. T.B.A. games will also be posted on the clubhouse notice board after play.
- 10. Games must start on time and umpires are asked to throw the ball in on time in all grades. If not the Club captain will be authorized to throw the ball in and start play
