THE 2010 OPEN IN ARGENTINA WITH BRUCE EYRES.

Day 1 Wednesday 24 November 2010
Departure/Buenos Aires
Tour members depart Sydney on a Lan Chile flight to Buenos Aires via Santiago. The flight crosses the International Date Line and arrives in Buenos Aires in the afternoon. The group will be transferred to their centrally located Buenos Aires hotel. The afternoon will be free - there will a welcome drinks party before dinner.

Day 2 Thursday 25 November 2010
Buenos Aires
After breakfast we will tour the main sights of Buenos Aires with a local guide. We will see the main symbol of the city, the obelisk and tour the squares of Plaza del Mayo, Plaza San Martin, Plaza Congreso and the wide avenues of Corrientes, May and 9 de Julio. We will see the historical neighbourhoods of La Boca, san Telmo and Montserrat and the elegant neighbourhoods of Palermo and Recoleta, and the modern area of Puerto Madero.

A good value local restaurant will be recommended.

Bruce is a grain producer and livestock breeder from Western Australia who played polo from 1978 to 1992. He was president of the Western Australia Polo Association in 1988 and 1989. Bruce has travelled to enjoy watching polo in Asia, America, New Zealand and Argentina

Day 3 Friday 26 November 2010
Buenos Aires
A free day for independent sightseeing and relaxation in Buenos Aires. You may choose to visit the fine restaurants and shops in Recoleta.

Day 4 Saturday 27 November 2010
Buenos Aires
The group will come together at lunchtime before a full afternoon with reserved seating at the 2010 Polo Open in Buenos Aires. We will enjoy two games.. Everyone has a great day at this world famous event. The evening will be at leisure.

Tour Details

The price for the thirteen-night tour is \$ 5750.00 per person twin share. Single supplement is \$ 1100.00 per person. The land only price for the tour (no flights) is \$ 3500.00 per person twin share. International and general travel taxes and fuel surcharges are additional. At 5 March 2010 they were approximately \$ 200.50 per person for economy class. Please call for business class fares and for fares on other airlines.

Included in the tour price:

- Return economy class air travel from Sydney to Buenos Aires and from Buenos Aires to Iguassu Falls. Long haul travel will be on Lan Chile/Qantas. Please call for other departure cities. Passengers will be able to extend their stay in South America. Please enquire concerning optional independent post-tour trips to Cusco, Machu Picchu and other destinations.
- Accommodation in three and four star hotels with private facilities. Hotel taxes and service charges.
- A full breakfast daily.
- Sightseeing and general entrances as detailed in the itinerary.
- Entrance with reserved seating for three days at the Polo Open in Buenos Aires.
- Tour leadership by Bruce Eyres, with support from local English speaking tour operators and guides in South America..
- A Travelrite International travel bag.

Not included in the tour price:

- Passport and visa fees.
- International airport and general travel taxes.
- Travel insurance.
- Sightseeing and general expenses not specified in the itinerary.
- Items of a personal nature.
- Additional travel arrangements – these will be quoted for separately.

General Information and Booking Conditions

Tour Operator. Travelrite International Pty Ltd (ABN 64 005 817 078) is the tour operator.

Tour Prices. The tour prices are based on airfare, general transport, accommodation and other costs at foreign exchange rates at 5 March 2010. Travelrite International reserves the right to alter the tour price or modify the tour if any of these factors change, giving any passenger who has booked the right to withdraw with a full refund of monies paid. No alteration to the tour price will be made within 60 days of departure from Australia.

Deposits and Payments. A deposit of \$ 500.00 per person is required at the time of booking. Full payment will be required 60 days before departure.

Changes. After confirmation of travel arrangements, one change to travel arrangements will be provided free of charge. Subsequent changes to travel arrangements will incur a fee of \$ 25.00 for each change.

Cancellations. Cancellations advised more than 60 days from the date of departure from Australia will incur a cancellation fee of \$ 300.00 per person. Cancellations advised 60 days or less from the date of departure from Australia will result in the loss of all monies paid. Travel insurance is strongly recommended to cover the cost of cancellation fees that could result from a death in the family, illness, etc.

Minimum Tour Numbers. The tour has been priced on the basis of a minimum number of passengers having booked on the tour 60 days prior to departure. Travelrite International reserves the right to cancel the tour if insufficient passengers have booked by 60 days prior to departure, giving a full refund of all monies paid, or offering arrangements to proceed with the tour at a modified price.

Refunds. The tour is based on arrangements that do not allow for any refunds in respect of sightseeing, accommodation, meals, airfare or other services not utilized after the tour has commenced.

Travel Documents. All passengers will need to be in possession of a valid passport.

Passengers holding other than an Australian passport should check requirements with Travelrite International.

Baggage. Economy class passengers qualify for a 20kg. airline baggage allowance.

Changes to the Tour Itinerary. Travelrite International reserves the right to make changes to the tour itinerary to fit in with operational requirements. Any change to the itinerary will be replaced with similar arrangements with an equal or greater value.

Responsibility. Travelrite International Pty Ltd (ABN 64 005 817 078), Licence No 30858) is the tour organizer. Travelrite International acts only as agent in making arrangements with carriers, hoteliers and others for the tour.
