Chile flight to Buenos Aires via Santiago.
The flight crosses the International Date
Line and arrives in Buenos Aires in the
afternoon. The group will be transferred to
their centrally located Buenos Aires hotel.
The afternoon will be free - there will a
welcome drinks party before dinner.

Day 2 Thursday 25 November 2010 Buenos Aires
After breakfast we will tour the main sights
of Buenos Aires with a local guide. We will
see the main symbol of the city, the obelisk
and tour the squares of Plaza del Mayo,
Plaza San Martin, Plaza Congreso and the
wide avenues of Corrientes, May and 9 de
Julio. We will see the historical
neighbourhoods of La Boca, san Telmo and
Montserrat and the elegant neighbourhoods
of Palermo and Recoleta, and the modern
area of Puerto Madero.

A good value local restaurant will be recommended.

Day 3 Friday 26 November 2010

Buenos Aires
A free day for independent sightseeing and relaxation in Buenos Aires. You may choose to visit the fine restaurants and shops in Recoleta.

Day 4 Saturday 27 November 2010 Buenos Aires

The group will come together at lunchtime before a full afternoon with reserved seating at the 2010 Polo Open in Buenos Aires We will enjoy two games.. Everyone has a great day at this world famous event. The evening will be at leisure.

Day 5 Sunday 28 November 2010 Buenos Aires

A full afternoon with reserved seating at the 2010 Polo Open in Buenos Aires. There will be two games. The evening will be at leisure.

Day 6 Monday 29 November 2010 Iquassu Falls

After breakfast we transfer to the Buenos Aires domestic airport to join our two hour flight north to Iguassu Falls. The Iguassu Falls were declared UNESCO world heritage sites in 1984 and 1986. The waterfall system consists of 275 separate falls along 2.7 km of the Iguassu River. The falls cascade in a wide horseshoe that is known as the Devil's Throat, an impressive waterfall which forms northern Argentina's natural border with Brazil.

Day 7 Tuesday 30 November 2010 Iguassu Falls

A full day of sightseeing at the Iguassu Falls with a local guide. We will first of all see the falls from the Argentina side and after lunch cross into Brazil for an outstanding panoramic view.

Dinner will be at leisure in Iguassu Falls.

Day 8 Wednesday 1 December 2010

Buenos Aires

After breakfast we check out from our hotel and transfer to Iguassu Falls airport for our flight to Buenos Aires. On arrival we will be transferred to our hotel and the rest of the days will be at leisure. Buenos Aires has some of the best value shopping in the world.

Day 9 Thursday 2 December 2010 Buenos Aires

After breakfast we travel by private coach into the countryside for a visit to a well known polo horse breeder. We will tour the farm, meet the owners and key personnel at the establishment and discuss the polo industry. Lunch will be at leisure in a local restaurant and we will return to Buenos Aires for an afternoon at leisure.

Day 10 Friday 3 December 2010 Buenos Aires

We travel by private coach for a day of exploration on the canals on the delta of the

River Plate, north of Buenos Aires. We will enjoy a boat trip through the canals and see some of the grand holiday houses used as getaways by the locals. Lunch will be at leisure. We return to Buenos Aires late afternoon.

Day 11 Saturday 4 December 2010 Buenos Aires

We will come together at lunchtime prior to a the much anticipated final of the 2010 Polo Open in Buenos Aires. The evening will be at leisure.
