LOW GOAL TOURNAMENT RULES

All games are 4 chukkas. Winners of Game 1 and Game 2 (round robin) will play in the final on Sunday. Losing teams will play in Sunday's round robin.

To make way for the fund raising activities on the main field, Saturday's games in the low-goal will be played on our number 2 field – located on another property "Cara" about 7km from the main field. See directions below. Sunday's games will be on the main field at Millamolong.

Sundays draw and duties to be determined on Saturday evening.

All games are played to result.

All games are played on handicap.

Saturday's duties have been assigned. If for any reason you feel you cannot do your duties you may ask an able person to fill in for you. Umpires may not swap duties without approval from the tournament committee.

Failure to do duties on time will result in penalties.

GENERAL

There is zero tolerance for bad language on the field or any back chat towards the umpires.

In the event of bad weather or any unforeseen circumstances Millamolong Polo Club reserves the right to change venues or times and will give as much notice as possible.

Directions to the #2 field:

"Cara" 1171 Belubula Way Mandurama

From the Millamolong Polo Club, drive back to the bitumen road and turn left (east) onto Belubula Way towards Mandurama and Sydney. After about 2km, you will pass two cottages – one on the right and one further up on the left. The gate to "Cara" is directly opposite the second cottage. Turn right onto a gravel road and then follow signs to the field.

From Mandurama, drive west for 11.7 km along the Canowindra Road (aka Belubula Way). Slow down as you approach the small cottage on the right hand side of the road. The gate to "Cara" is directly opposite this cottage. Turn left onto a gravel road and then follow signs to the field.
